- Capital project updates:
  - The contract for pavement renovation at C-Ramp and Eagle Point Recreation Areas has been awarded. A letter of support for an Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife Restoration and Enhancement Grant was approved by the PRAB and signed by Chair Baron at the November meeting. Our project was selected for funding and will formally be awarded in March.
  - o Sign design firm identified and working on contracting. Ideally new entrance sign for Scoggins Valley Park will be in place this fiscal year.
  - O CXT restrooms for C-Ramp and Elks Recreation Areas will be ordered in the new year. No updates.
  - Staff received quotes from design firm for plans and specifications for ADA ramp from south C-Ramp parking lot to adjacent restrooms.

- Eagle Landing Park —Feasibility Study for new river access complete. Identifying funding will happen at some undetermined point in the future.
- Citations citation are being issued. At an upcoming meeting PRAB would like to discuss fine amounts.
